



**Re-setting the road safety button**

Experienced drivers often become complacent and fall into bad driving habits. The BetterDriver workshop aims to challenge those habits and build motivation for safer driving.

The BetterDriver workshop is an open discussion, designed for groups of 15-20 participants and is guided by RSE facilitators. The two-hour workshop focusses on the highest risk areas for experienced drivers and gives participants the opportunity to share their experience with colleagues and develop strategies for change. The workshop features the use of a personalised Action Plan for participants to record thoughts, tips and intentions and, importantly discuss with their family. RSE use pre and post evaluation data from participants to help guide the workshop discussion and reinforce the messaging.

**Workshop Objectives**

- Increase knowledge and skills to become a safer driver (low-risk driving)
- Discuss hazards, distractions and risks and their role in crashes – develop strategies to manage
- Investigate speeding and stopping distances and see how slowing down saves lives
- Identify how alcohol, medications and fatigue affects driving
- Realise how complacency can increase the chances of a crash and understand the safety role of mindful driving
- Show participants how their personality is an important aspect of road safety
- Understand modern safety features and how to maintain a safe vehicle
